The Scientific Program Committee welcomes the submission of free communication abstracts for presentation. Free communications will be presented in one of the following formats:

- ORAL
- POSTER

You are to select either an oral presentation or a poster presentation, however, the Scientific Committee reserves the right to make the final decision concerning the form of presentation.

FORM OF PRESENTATION

POSTER

Abstracts selected for posters will be presented as posters during the Meeting and will be available for viewing in the poster area.

Poster printed size: 0,90 x 1,50 metres

Poster's authors will have to be in front of their poster in due time on Friday and Saturday (during the coffee break), to answer any questions regarding their poster.

The poster's discussions will be between the author and the participants that might have questions.

We will inform you in due time if your poster will be discussed on Friday or Saturday.

ORAL PRESENTATION

Abstracts selected for oral presentations will be presented during the Meeting.

Presenting authors will receive all technical information and instructions prior to the Meeting in order to ensure the smooth running of sessions.

Computer projection facilities (for PowerPoint presentations) will be available in the meeting rooms.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. General information

- An abstract of up to **1500 characters** must be submitted **only in English**.
- The authors should avoid abbreviations. When mentioning drugs, their names should be in line with the international nomenclature.
- Abstracts may only be submitted online
- The deadline for abstract submission is **June 30, 2021**.
- Each submitted abstract will be qualified for acceptance anonymously by independent reviewers.
- The authors will be informed whether their submissions have been accepted or rejected by **July 15, 2021**.

2. Topic categories for the abstracts

You should specify one topic category within which the submitted abstract falls:

- Trichoscopy
- Hair disorders
- Nail disorders
- Cosmetics

3. Abstract layout

- Abstract should be maximum 1500 characters with space and structured according to enclosed **template abstract**.
- You can directly use the template without changing the format. Please fit the abstract into 2 pages of ISO A4 sized (210 mm x 297 mm) paper, single-sided with a top margin of 25 mm and side and bottom margins of 20 mm. Use of Arial font (or equivalent) is strongly recommended.
- The title of the abstract is aligned left with Arial font in 11-point boldface.
- Authors' names appear below the title in 11-point boldface. Mark affiliations using superscripted letters (starting from 1). Underline the presenting author's name and asterisk (*) the corresponding author's name. The affiliations and the contact information (and email address) are italicised in 11-point. The affiliations are given as department and institution names with country.
- The body of the abstract of an **original study** should be divided into five sections: Background, Aims and Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions.
- The abstract of a **clinical case** should be divided into three sections: Background, Observation, Key Message.
- Submit your Word file on the website of the 2WCT 2021 (www.worldcongresstrichoscopy2021.com). The final word file that is to be uploaded should not exceed the size limit of 2 MB.
